



2005 CAITLIN'S RESERVE CHARDONNAY – *Media Reviews*

91 Attractive aromas of wet stone, pear and red apple are followed by similar flavors plus bright, lemony citrus on a light-on-its-feet frame. 'Pretty' is the word for this wine, made from clone 76 grapes grown in the Stoller Vineyards in the Dundee Hills appellation. Fermented in French oak barrels and with complete malolactic fermentation-which might suggest softness and a woody character-this wine is anything but that. Rather, it is bright in its fruit notes and crisply textured. —Linda Murphy
